First homework task

Module 5, unit 5 (Logo, pages 86 and 87)

Lesson objectives:

- j) To be able to ask for and give directions
- ii) To be able to use “zu + the dative case”

Pupils are to design their own maps either of an area they know such as Cambridge or of an imaginary area. They should label their maps with the relevant names of the buildings, e.g. the shops. Pupils should then write 10 questions to ask how to best get to one of the buildings labelled on their maps, e.g. “Wie komme ich am besten zum Dom?” = How do I best get to the cathedral? They will need to use zu + dative case to write these sentences (See Logo, page 87). Pupils should then answer 5 of the questions they have written using appropriate directions (See Logo, page 86) and they should leave 5 of the questions unanswered so that their partner can answer them next lesson. Some pupils may choose to make use of both the “du” and “Sie” forms when writing answers to their questions whilst others may decide to stick to just one of the forms (See Logo, page 86).

This piece of work will be peer assessed and will be used for display.

Second homework task

Module 6, unit 2 (Logo, pages 98 and 99)

Lesson objectives:

- i) To be able to talk about what you like to wear
- ii) To be able to use “Ich trage + the accusative case”

Pupils are to select five different occasions and are to describe what they usually wear for that occasion and what they prefer to wear, (See Logo, page 99, Schreiben 4a for support). All pupils should make use of “Ich trage + the accusative case” and of the new clothes vocabulary that they have learnt in the lesson. Some pupils may wish to include colours, sizes, reasons and opinions in their sentences. Pupils may also choose to include a sentence to describe what their friend or a member of their family usually wears and prefers to wear on a given occasion. Pupils should aim to write approx. half a page for this task.

This piece of work will be teacher assessed and will be marked as a level 4-5 piece of work.
