If responses are not referred to in the report, it does not mean that parents'/carers' views have not been considered. Where concerns are made about a child's safety, inspectors may pass on the information.

Speaking to an inspector

It may be possible to speak to an inspector during the inspection, for instance at the start of the school day. Inspection administrators will be happy to pass on messages to the inspectors if you are unable to speak to them in person, although inspectors may not be able to contact you directly themselves. You can contact the administrators on 01223 463998. Inspectors will be pleased to receive your comments, but cannot deal with complaints concerning individual pupils or settle disputes between you and the school.
